Kennel Care Taker

- Responsibilities: Feeding, Watering, Walking Dogs, Scooping, Scrubbing, & Rinsing kennels, Laundry, Taking out the trash,
 Setting up Kennels, Keeping an eye on the health and behavior of the dogs.
- Training: Attend Volunteer Orientation. Training will begin with hands on instruction, followed by information from packets A,B,C,&D finally there will be a quiz to graduate to a Green vest, and become an official Kennel Care Taker
- o **Time Commitment:** At least one day per week for four hours (8-12 am).

"Catch-us-ups"

Do you want to help in any way you can? Want to see what happens on a daily basis at an animal shelter? Want to help, but aren't sure how yet? Then "Catch-us-ups" is the job for you.

- o **Responsibilities:** Assist with shots, Clean crates, Laundry, Dishes, Clean Syringes, Help with daily tasks, Varies widely.

Groomer

- Responsibilities: Bathe, Brush, Clean Ears, Trim nails.

Photographer

- Responsibilities: Take pictures & videos of our animals; Get them to us within 24hrs.

- o Time Commitment: At least one day per week for 1 hour (Noon-5PM Tue-Fri, 10AM-4PM Sat)

Tour Guide

If you are a people person, then help us reach out to the community.

- o **Responsibilities:** Answer phones, Talk to clients, Show people around the shelter, Introduce animals that fit what possible adopters are looking for, Speak knowledgably about our animals, programs, & policies. Speak at community events about AH.
- Training: Attend Volunteer Orientation. Training will begin with hands on instruction, followed by information from packets A,E,G,H,I &K, finally there will be a quiz to graduate to a Blue vest, and become an official Tour Guide.
- Time Commitment: At least one day per week for 1 hour (Noon-5PM Tue-Fri, 10AM-4PM Sat)

Office Assistant

Help us: help adopters find pets, owners fix behavior problems, lost pets get returned and so much more.

- Responsibilities: Answer phones, Do adoption/ Intake/ Low Income Neuter paper work, Enter information into our computer system, check messages, organize paperwork & office, Update waitlist & wish list, Update lost & found board.
- Training: : Attend Volunteer Orientation. Training will begin with hands on instruction, followed by information from packets
 A,B,G,H,I,J &K finally there will be a quiz to graduate to a Blue vest, and become an official Office Assistant.
- Time Commitment: At least one day per week for 1 hour (Noon-5PM Tue-Fri, 10AM-4PM Sat)

Advertising
